MYRTLE RUST In November 2017 myrtle rust was found on several hundred ramarama plants at





a commercial plant production property in Waimauku . Myrtle rust can cause significant damage to plants such as pōhutukawa, mānuka, kanuka and rāta and can kill mature trees. No country has successfully eradicated the disease. Myrtle rust spores are microscopic and can easily be spread across large distances by wind, or via insects, birds, people or machinery. If you discover or think you might have found myrtle rust, MPI asks that you not touch it but take a photo and call 0800 80 99 66. **KAURI DIEBACK** Our unique Kauri is threatened with extinction. There is no cure for kauri dieback, it can be spread by just a pinhead of soil, and you can't tell by looking whether a tree is infected or not. The fight to save kauri involves everyone. **FRESHWATER ECOLOGY** Massey University have completed some research into the state of the waterways within the South Kaipara. Dr Russell Death will present their findings shortly and will be seeking feedback from whanau.

MANA WHENUA SPEED MANAGEMENT CONSULTATION

Auckland Transport (AT) are consulting iwi, hapu and community groups over the next three years to examine current speed limits on local roads (not State Highways) and to talk about road risks and speeds. Reduction in speeds is one tool to use to improve road safety but the Auckland Transport safety programme also includes engineering, driver education and community engagement to improve road safety.

Right now AT are asking for names of roads or sections of roads that you would specifically like to be reviewed and they are collecting names and contact details from people who would like to be included in consultation activities.
