NGAHERE LTD PÄNUI

NOTICE

Hancock Forest Management (HFMNZ), who have a licence to operate in Woodhill Forest, have made us aware of the following.

Harvesting operations are relocated to areas next to Tasman Road (North Block Woodhill Forest) on 12 March 2018.



As operations will be next to Tasman Road, it will be necessary to close the Tasman Public Access Easement to members of the public until harvest in this area is completed.

There is no alternative access.

Therefore HFMNZ has notified the Crown that the Tasman Road Public Access Easement will be closed due to health and safety and operational reasons.

Closure started at sunset 11 March 2018. The period of closure is from sunset Sunday to Sunrise Saturday.

This will mean the Tasman Road Public Access Easement will only be open on Saturday and Sunday during daylight hours.

It is anticipated that the weekday closure of the Tasman Public Access Easement may extend until the end of July 2018.

This will be reviewed on an on-going basis, and when operational or health and safety considerations permit, the Public Access Easement will be advertised as open again for as long as operational or health and safety conditions permit.

EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

Ngā Maunga Whakahii o Kaipara Ngahere Ltd wishes to build on Woodhill Forest's position as an adventure / recreational tourism destination. We also want to further explore what other non-tourism businesses could locate there.

The Ngāti Whatua o Kaipara owned Ararimu Block of Riverhead Forest at present has no co-located activities in addition to forestry, and Ngahere Ltd is interested in the possibility of introducing these at that location.
