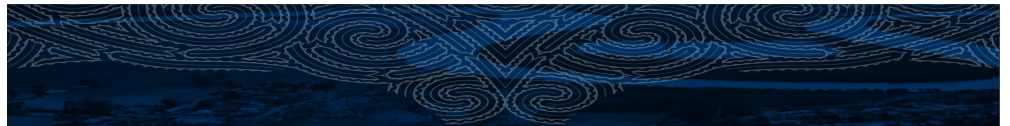

## SCHOLARSHIPS

The objectives of our Ngāti Whātua o Kaipara Scholarships are to:

- Acknowledge our commitment to supporting education success
- Provide a significant financial contribution for students in areas of study aligned with the strategic objectives of Ngā Maunga Whakahii o Kaipara.

Scholarships are contestable, merit based and have a maximum value of \$15,000 over the tenure of the studies.



## ELIGIBILITY

The 2018/2019 Scholarships are open to all iwi registered beneficiaries who are completing tertiary studies in Aotearoa. The priority study areas are listed below and Undergraduate students are preferred however all study programmes and all tertiary students are still encouraged to apply.

**LEADERSHIP/MAORI DEVELOPMENT** i.e. Management, Te Reo , Political Science, Resource Management, Development

**SCIENCES** i.e. Agri or Api culture, Marine & Forest Ecology

**HEALTH** i.e. Medicine, Social Work, Education

**BUSINESS** i.e. Commerce, Property, Finance, Economics, Law, IT

**TRADES** i.e. Apprenticeships, construction & infrastructure

Incomplete applications will not be accepted.



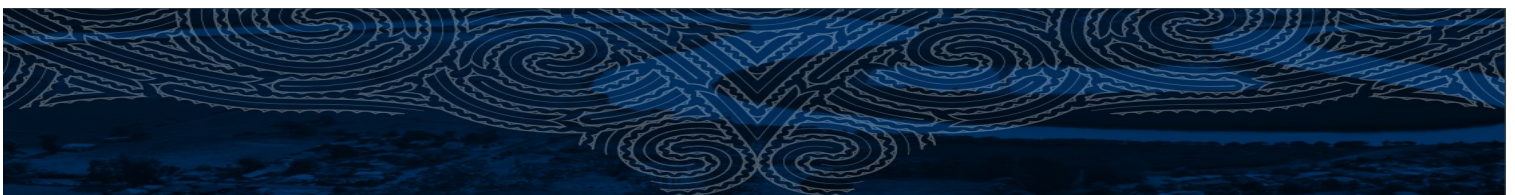
# TIMEFRAMES?

- Applications must be submitted by **5pm Friday 1 February 2019**. You should receive a notification of receipt . If you do not hear from us within 15 working days please contact the office to check that it has been received.
- Due to the value of scholarships awarded the assessment process is more intensive than other financial contributions that we have available. You may be required to attend an interview at your own cost and an award could include a bonding agreement. Please consider this when applying.
