- 2. To be eligible to hold office as the Marae Trustee Representative on the Ngā Maunga Whakahii o Kaipara Board, the person **must**:
 - a) be recorded on the Ngā Maunga Whakahii o Kaipara Register as primarily affiliating to the marae that he or she is seeking to represent; and
 - b) attend the election hui at the marae which they are seeking to represent, according to the schedule below; and
